The Welcome Party provides an opportunity for Parents and Junior Golfers to meet and interact with the camp instructors. If you are new to the program, this is a great time to get familiar with the facility. We will have complimentary games and contests for the juniors to test their skills. General Information

Each week, pick-up and drop-off will be on the practice range, next to the performance center building. One of our golf professional staff will be with the golfers until everyone has been picked up.

When on property, please remember the following:

- No child is allowed to operate a golf car
- Proper golf etiquette must be used at all times. Golf professionals have the right to protect the other participants and the golf course. This may mean excusing your child from activities.
- Soft spikes or athletic shoes must be worn, please no sandals or other sport cleats.

In case of inclement weather, we will notify everyone via email and through the Oaks Facebook page. Please be sure to stay on top of one of these feeds to be notified of changes. We aim to notify everyone at least one hour in advance. Please note, make up days for rainouts will be instruction only. We will issue each golfers a rain check for 9-holes of golf, good for one calendar year.

Each participant will need to have their own set of golf clubs. We suggest clubs that are fitted to the child's height and strength. If you need assistance with proper fitting, please contact Joey or the Oaks golf shop.

You are not required to notify us if your child will miss a session. However, if you do feel like giving us a heads up, please contact Joey at joeleonard@golftheoaks.com. Also, we do not offer make-up sessions for days that your child misses, we only offer make-ups for rainouts.

Parental involvement is a valued component of The Oaks Junior Program. While it is not required, we do appreciate having parents attend sessions to observe and potentially lend an extra set of eyes and hands to help the kids...especially during the on-course play portion of our programming.
